HOW TO SEND YOUR SPECS TO US

If you have just a few pairs of spectacles that you would like to send to us, please telephone Sue Boucher who will try to direct you towards our nearest local collection point.

To avoid unnecessary handling, we would be grateful if you would throw away the following before shipment:

- Cases other than those in excellent condition.
- Loose lenses which have already been shaped to fit frames

You may send all your specs to us **FREE OF CHARGE** by PARCELFORCE.

1. Pack the specs loose in stout well sealed boxes, each measuring no more than 50 x 33 x 33cm (20 x 13 x 13 ins) with a maximum weight of 10 kg
2. Address them to: Chichester Lions Club, c/o The Apuldrum Centre, Common Farm, Appledram Lane South, Chichester, West Sussex, PO20 7PE
3. Mark each parcel: **ARTICLES FOR THE BLIND - CONTRACT NO. R233259**
4. Please include your name and address, preferably on a separate sheet inside the parcel. We like to send donators acknowledgement and ensure that you receive our newsletter.
5. Phone the Parcel Force Datapost Collection Centre on 03448 00 44 66 and quote our contract no. R233259 - request the 48 hour service.

If you are local to Chichester or visiting the area, you can bring them personally to our workshop at The Apuldrum Centre where the spectacles are sorted. A bin is located outside the gate into which the spectacles can be deposited. Let us know when you are coming and if possible we can welcome you and show you what we do.

On our website you can find a list of shops and opticians in Chichester which have our collection bins where spectacles and hearing aids can be deposited.



We have supplied local stores, surgeries, hospitals and opticians with specially prepared collection bins. These have proved a great success. We can provide the signage to other clubs for application to locally purchased bins.
